January 25, 2006

Agenda Items:

1. Tim Roache from Strafford Regional Planning Commission gave a presentation on the transportation study for Route 125 that he is working on. The area of the study is from Route 101 to the Spaulding Turnpike (1000ft on both sides of the centerline.) Phase 1 is data collection which is nearing completion. Phase 2 will be a build-out and is expected to be finished by the Fall of 2006. BORWPP members gave comments generally focused on the area of Lee Traffic Circle and wetlands near the corridor.
2. Minutes from December meeting were approved.
3. Next meeting (Friday, Feb. 24, 7pm) will be a joint meeting with the Oyster River Watershed Association. Ted Walsh from NH DES Volunteer River Assessment Program will report on the 2005 monitoring of the Bellamy and Oyster Rivers.
