

## Invitation to a Gathering

The Bellamy and Oyster River Watershed Protection Partnership (BORWPP) invites local decision makers, board, and commission members to discuss regional water issues and strategies for cooperation.

Formed in 2004 and represented by municipally appointed members from Barrington, Dover, Durham, Lee, Madbury, Portsmouth, and UNH, BORWPP meets monthly to discuss water related issues in the Bellamy and Oyster River watersheds.

The gathering, to be held on **November 12, 2009, 7:00pm at the Madbury Town Hall** will feature three short regional water issue presentations (as noted below) followed by a discussion period. Our intent is to provide an opportunity for learning and informal discussion.

### Directions

The Madbury Town Hall is located at 13 Town Hall Road, just a few hundred yards from the Rt. 155 and Madbury Road intersection (blinking light).

From Portsmouth and Durham: From the traffic light at Rt. 4 and Madbury Rd, travel north (half mile) to the blinking light at Rt. 155, turn left and then a quick right on to Town Hall Rd.

From Lee: Travel toward Dover on Rt. 155 and find Town Hall Rd on your left, just after the Moharimet Elementary School and Demeritt Park ball fields.

From Barrington and Dover: From the intersection at Rt. 9, Rt 16, and Rt. 155, travel south past Kingman Farm and the Madbury Safety Complex, turn right onto Town Hall Rd just after the blinking light.
